

Here is a summary of the divine appointment principles that I have shared with you over the last 58 chapters. These are good reminders for me to review often. Our God is always at work.

1. God loves to surprise us with a clear demonstration of His power. Expect it.
2. I must be ready to instantly respond to where God is leading. Be flexible.
3. Our God has a real sense of humor. He shows us that side of Him so we can laugh with Him.
4. When God abruptly changes your plans, expect a divine appointment.
5. In the midst of a temptation to respond emotionally, look for God's bigger picture.
6. Often we need to allow God to open the door for a divine appointment.
7. God is even more interested than we are in having people read His Word.
8. Sometimes I want to rest but God wants me to bless others through a divine appointment. I can trust Him to take care of my needs.
9. Some divine appointments are ho hum. Others are amazingly wild. Go with what God does.
10. God will work way beyond my own self-serving desires.
11. People don't need our judgment. They need our prayers.
12. I need to simply obey regardless if it makes sense to me at the moment.
13. Expect God to move supernaturally at any time.
14. My perceived purpose for me being in a place may be totally different from God's actual purpose.
15. Don't say "No" for other people. Ask the question anyway. God may open an amazing door.
16. God can interrupt our schedule at any time He chooses.
17. God often expects us to show boldness, but He always expects us to show love.

18. God's timing is split-second perfect.
19. God knows how to work in spite of overwhelming odds.
20. God works with incredible power in meticulous ways.
21. Sometimes we are part of the answer to our divine appointment's prayer request.
22. Most encounters can lead to a prayer request regardless of the reason for the encounter.
23. Some divine appointments are searching for something that we have.
24. Sometimes divine appointments are too obvious to miss.
25. Make sure the person is more important than the activity with the person.
26. It is not about your divine appointment's faith in God, it is all about yours.
27. God will lead us in how to challenge a divine appointment. Follow His lead.
28. God knows how to grant us favor with divine appointments (even ahead of time).
29. God knows how to use us to affirm others' obedience.
30. God knows how to use divine appointments to teach us character.
31. God will bring divine appointments into our lives at critical moments in their lives.
32. Sometimes God provides a second chance at a divine appointment when we miss the first one.
33. God can bring out the real need to be praying for in a divine appointment's life.
34. God knows how to connect some divine appointments with my friends in order for Him to receive the greatest glory.
35. God knows how to bring divine appointments across our paths who are hurting deeply.
36. God expects us to be kind and gracious to our divine appointments.

37. God knows how to push our “blessed” button with a divine appointment.
38. God’s timing with divine appointments is perfect.
39. No one is outside of God’s reach. Just love them.
40. In spite of me not being at my best, God can still work supernaturally through me. It is all about His abilities, not mine.
41. We can even pray divine appointments into our lives.
42. God knows the best way to present truth to our divine appointments.
43. If I focus on my needs and desires, I will typically miss great divine appointments.
44. Pray for our divine appointments to be “right” with God.
45. God can be specifically preparing us for a divine appointment several days in advance.
46. God will give the right question to ask our divine appointment. Just listen.
47. When I find myself hanging out with a stranger, I can be sure that it is a divine appointment.
48. God looks for ways to glorify Himself through our divine appointments.
49. God knows how to connect us to others in a divine appointment in order to provide a “bridge” for them to return to Him.
50. Sometimes a divine appointment will lead us to a second divine appointment.
51. Don’t underestimate how deeply God can impact a divine appointment’s heart.
52. Do not be ashamed of our God.
53. God is at work in everyone we meet even if we cannot “see” it.
54. It is OK to pray for the wrong person. God knows what He is doing.
55. I can be in the wrong place and God can still work supernaturally.

56. God knows how to provide divine appointments with those who live near us, even on airplanes or by delivering mail.

57. Divine appointments can happen anywhere and at any time. Just be alert.

58. When God is leading us somewhere we don't want to go, go anyway. He often has a divine appointment waiting.
